## With the help of these cards your child will learn about diversity!

- 1. Tell the child that there are a lot of people on the Earth and everyone is unique, but all of them are wonderful.
- **2.** Show the child the Montessori Continents Map and tell that people living on these continents are all different.
- **3.** Take one continent and put it at the top.
- 4. Show different pictures of children living there.
- **5.** Then show the mark of the continent at every picture and make clear that it shows the same continent. It will then serve as control of error.
- 6. Study pictures with children of the continents one by one.

Print all the material and cut it out. Then glue the name of the country or region to the back of every card. Laminate


